To promote a continuous increased membership to achieve the aims and objectives of the organization.

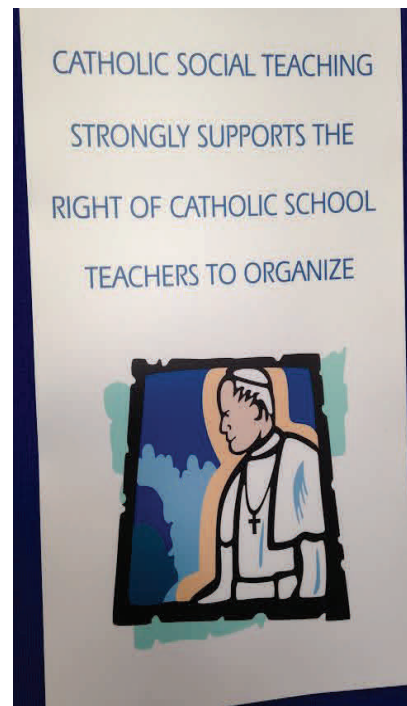
To help achieve affordability for our Catholic School students by offering scholarships to eligible students.
